Dance Audition Requirements

Attire: Dancers should wear dance clothing that shows the line of the body, but leotard and tights are not required. Hair should be secured away from the face.

Audition: Dancers should prepare a 60-90 second dance solo in any style. Auditionees may be asked to demonstrate proficiency in other dance styles at the request of the audition panel. The dance portion of the audition will be followed by an informal interview.

Scholarship Requirements

Students are to be enrolled in classes as per Wallace State Scholarship requirements.

Dance scholarship recipients must be enrolled in at least one dance technique class each semester.

Dance scholarship students must participate in at least one dance ensemble in order to retain scholarship, and attend all rehearsals and performances required for that ensemble. Ensemble commitment is per academic year, not per semester.

Students must maintain a semester GPA of 2.5.
