Licensure of dental hygienists in the United States is the responsibility of individual states, the District of Columbia, and the District of Columbia jurisdictions, with licensure decisions made by jurisdictional dental boards. Specific dental hygiene licensure requirements vary by jurisdiction, but most jurisdictions have three basic requirements: an educational requirement, a written clinical examination requirement.
